- Personal care basics
- Household items
- Fresh produce and bread
- Frozen meat

Walk-in Produce Visit *(anytime during distribution hours)*

- Fresh produce and bread
- Meat and dairy (when available)

Who can come to the pantry?

Any household living at 200% of the federal poverty level or less is eligible.

How do I sign up?

Simply go to lssfoodpantries.org, register and place an order. If you need assistance, please call **877-LSS-MEAL** weekdays **10 a.m. - 1 p.m.** You will receive points based on your family size and will be able to use those points on any available items.

What if I can't make it to a distribution?

You can have someone pick up for you. Just send them with a signed letter of proxy stating your household meets income guidelines and listing the person's name who can pick up your order.

What if I only want produce?

You are welcome to come during distribution hours to pick out fresh produce and bread. No order or appointment needed.

What do I get with a full order appointment?

A full order appointment includes an assortment of pantry staples (like canned veggies, cooking oil, pasta, peanut butter, etc), personal care basics, household items, meat, bread and fresh produce.

How often can I visit the LSS Food Pantry?

You may come once a month for a full order appointment and come as much as you'd like for a walk-in produce visit.
